### 1. Community Service and Leadership

### 2. Essay

In a short essay, (250-300 words) write about the importance of and your commitment to volunteerism, community service and leadership. Discuss your plans for college and your future goals.

### 3. Reference/Recommendation Letters

Please attach two letters of reference/recommendation from members of the community (not family members), or your school who have supervised you in leadership or community service activities. The letter should attest to your personal commitment to the community as well as your leadership skills.
