Open 10:00 am – 5:00 pm every day. Opened in 1875 the zoo features exhibits like The Rainforest Aviary, The Big Cats of Asia, Wolf Woods, The Wonders of Nature, and the Penguin Exhibit.

- Greater Binghamton boasts beautiful architecture such as the **Phelps Mansion** ~ 191 Court Street, Binghamton, NY 13901 / (607) 722-4873 / www.phelpsmansion.org. Built for Sherman O. Phelps in 1870, it is a premier house featuring magnificent chandeliers, 13 foot ceilings, walnut, rosewood, maple and golden oak woods along with a soaring black walnut staircase. The Phelps Mansion is on the National Register of Historic Places.
