keeping your personal information to yourself, an identity thief can strike. If anyone has been a victim, follow these four steps: 1. Place a fraud alert on your credit reports and review your credit reports.

- 2. Close any accounts that have been tampered with or opened fraudulently.
- 3. File a report with your local police or the police in the community where the identity theft took place and keep a copy of the report. You may need this report to validate your claims to creditors. If you cannot get a copy of the report, at least get the report number.
- 4. File a complain with the FTC at www.consumer.gov/idtheft. The FTC Identity Theft hotline toll free is 1-877-IDTHEFT.
