### Same Application Format

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This year we will be keeping the same application format and process for acquiring Kamp reservations. Enclosed in this packet you will find 2008 Kamp applications, a club reservation sheet, information on Open House and a Kamp Kiwanis Wish List. Please only use the 2008 forms as new health information and social security information has been added. Please throw away any old forms. NYS Health Dept Regulations change from year to year and new formats have been added. This year the application is color coded to assist parents/guardians in the application process. Please do not forget this is a Club Kamper Reservation sheet to assist you in reserving Kamp spots.

### 2008 Kamp Fees

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As you may have read in the ESK, the total cost of Kamp has gone up this year due to high gas costs that effect every aspect of Kamp including food and supplies. This year the total child cost for the 2008 summer season is \$425.00 without transportation and \$525.00 with transportation. A Kiwanis sponsored adult cost is \$650.00 without transportation and \$800.00 with transportation. A CIT cost is \$225.00 without transportation, per session and \$325.00 with transportation, per session. **A \$200.00 deposit is required for all kampers.** All clubs are eligible for a "sponsor 10 get the 11th sponsorship free" discount. All applications and fees are due **4 weeks prior** to a kamp session.

### Special Needs

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If you are sponsoring a kamper with Special Needs, please contact Kamp first. We want to have room for every kamper, but we need to assure that there will be enough staff to service each camper's needs. ADD and ADHD are considered special needs. We only accept 20 kampers with special needs per week. These spaces fill first.

### Kamp Dates

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Please note that Session 1 begins Sunday July 6 and ends on Saturday July 12. Every session afterward will run from the following Sunday to Saturday and so on until our last session with runs from Sunday August 10 to Saturday August 16. Our data shows that our first few sessions are the hardest to fill, so this should help you. This year we are offering 1 adult session.

### Club Reservations

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Clubs can begin making reservations now for the 2008 summer season. Enclosed you will find a Club Reservation Form that will assist us here at Kamp to make a solid Kamp Reservation. We are unable to hold a spot without the \$200.00 non-refundable deposit per kamper. To help our clubs, we have now made it possible to use credit cards as a form of payment.

### Transportation

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On the back page of the application is this years bussing schedule, please note in an effort to keep down costs we have integrated some bus stops. We will contact each kamper and each club with bus times as soon as we know them. Drive-in times on Sunday are between 3:00pm and 4:00pm and pick-up is between 8:00am and 8:30am on closing day. All divisions that provide Drive-ins will be week 4. If this week is not possible please contact the Kamp.

### Health Form

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All kampers must submit the Kamp's Health Form. **Due to State Regulations, we can not accept in any instance alternate health record forms.**

### Complete Applications

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Please explain to parents/guardians that an application must be complete in it's entirety. Each blank space leaves us here at Kamp without valuable information that may assist us in providing your kamper the best possible care. We want to provide your kamper with the best times he or she can have away from home building wonderful memories and friendships.
