A full-time core of pediatric specialists, supported by pediatric residents and Fellows, along with an outstanding attending physician roster, provides any and all needed treatment.

Once a year, KPTC holds its Annual 'Black and White Ball' to celebrate the Kiwanis participation in this worthy cause. At this time, we reach out to the community for financial support offering an opportunity for professionals and business owners to subscribe to our commemorative journal.
