**Anton J. "Tony" Kaiser**  
**73rd President of Kiwanis International 1987-88**

A 1956 charter member and 1958 president of the Kiwanis Club of Farmingdale, Long Island, Tony Kaiser also served as lieutenant governor of the Long Island North Division in 1962. He was governor of the New York District in 1971-72 and in 1978-79 served as president to of the New York District Foundation

Tony has chaired and served on many District and International committees. He was elected to and served nine years on the International Board, including 1987 -88 as President of Kiwanis International, the first New Yorker to attain that position since the formation of the district in 1918.

Tony, who retired from the practice of law in 1987, is a life member of Kiwanis International. He has attended 33 District and 25 International Conventions and has perfect attendance since 1956. Tony and Mim were married in 1950 and have three married sons and six grandchildren.
